Community Feature GOING HOME

What does your organization do?

The mission at Going Home Hawai'i is to assist justice-involved Hawai'i Island men, women and youth with reintegration into community life through employment, education, housing and appropriate services.

Going Home Hawai'i (GHH) is the nonprofit entity of the Hawai'i Island Going Home Consortium and is Hawaii County's central resource to improve the lives and protect the health and wellbeing of people leaving corrections in Hawai'i. GHH is the state leader in innovative programs and partnerships that create a healthier and more equitable Hawai'i. For almost two decades, GHH has created multiple programs and partnerships to reduce recidivism, strengthen 'Ohana, and improve outcomes for those involved with the justice system.

How can those in need access your services?

All referrals are required to be sent to us via supervising authority/agency (probation, parole, lawyer, courts, intake service center, etc.)

How can the community get involved?

GHH believes we decrease the risk of new crimes and new victims by providing supportive services to meet the individualized needs of justice-involved persons experiencing barriers to successful reintegration and use a holistic approach of cultural inclusion and collaboration among community partners.

Nearly all incarcerated persons in Hawai'i will be released back to their communities at some point. Without help, returning prisoners face homelessness, unemployment, lack of training, substance abuse and mental health issues, poor social support, and a range of other issues. Far too many such individuals are at risk for violating their terms of supervision and new criminal offenses. Successful reintegration for the formerly incarcerated is one of the most important crime-prevention tools our communities have. With community support, they can achieve rehabilitation and become productive members of the community.
